



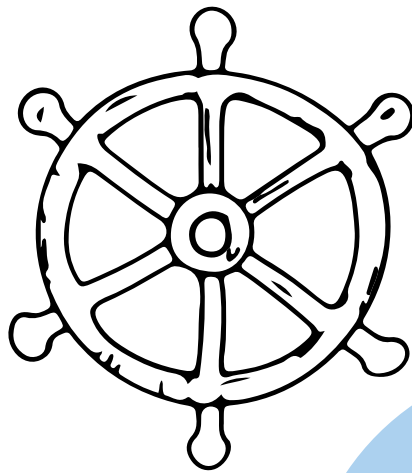
# CATAWBA ISLAND STATE PARK



Catawba Island State Park may be quaint, but it has much to offer. This place gets a lot of attraction due to its four boat launches making it a great place to launch boats and jet skis. The park has a little cobblestone beach used to launch kayaks, canoes, or paddle boards. There are lots of parking spots that are long enough for a car that is pulling a trailer. When going by the state park, a person is almost always seen sitting on the dock fishing. Lastly, the park offers a front-row seat to the sunset every night.
