

PERRY PARK PLAYGROUND



This playground was remodeled in 2021 to create a more inclusive playground for the visitors and members of the Lakeside Community. The playground is set right off the beautiful coast of Lake Erie, under big trees that offer shade in the summertime. The playground is quaint and surrounded by lots of grass in which to play. There is one ramp that leads to an Aeroglider that is handicap accessible. Along the ramp, there are some activity panels that offer opportunities for sensory play. However, the park does not offer any other activities for wheelchair-bound children. Ten steps lead to the elevated part of the playset where the telescope is for the children to look out onto Lake Erie. Something else to note is that this playground has no adapted swing options. A unique thing about this playground is that it has a scavenger hunt where both kids and parents can participate. The scavenger hunt entails finding color-coded objects throughout the playground.

WHAT IS OFFERED

Swings (Two regular swings and one baby swing) *
One ramp that is 48” wide * Activity panels perfect for sensory play * Five stairs that lead to telescope * Ten stairs that lead to slide * Scavenger hunt throughout the playground



ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Big trees offering lots of shade
- Multiple benches around the park and playground
- Picnic tables
- No parking
- Restrooms: closed during the winter
- Rubber playground surface
- Paved sidewalk leading up to the playground (Not shoveled during winter months)

TASKS

- Play on the playground
- Participate in the scavenger hunt
- Have a picnic
- Play on the grass
- Bring a ball and rackets to play tennis or pickleball
- Bring binoculars and look out at Lake Erie and bird watch (Sit at a picnic table and color)
- Walk along Ohio’s Most Beautiful Mile
