Port Clinton City Beach is a sandy beach along Lake Erie's shores full of people swimming and hanging out on the beach on a hot summer day. This beach is one of the few accessible beaches in Ohio, it has a Mobi-Mat that is ADA-approved for accessible beach access. The Mobi-Mat is non-slip and allows people with disabilities, wheelchairs, or parents with strollers to walk on it, instead of navigating the sandy terrain. The city of Port Clinton has a beach wheelchair that can be rented out Monday-Friday from 8:00 AM- 2:00 PM. This chair is made to be able to roll along the sand with ease.
